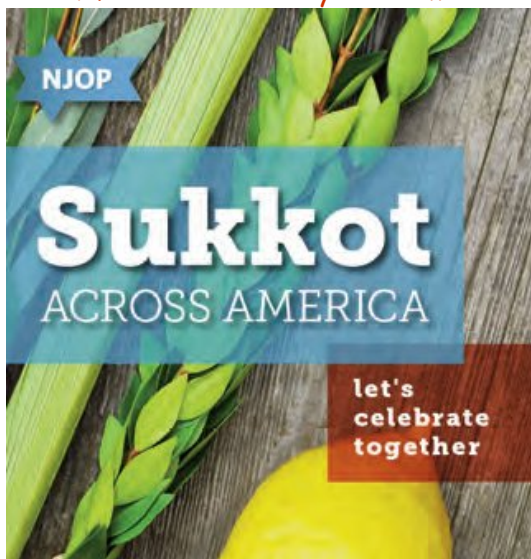
### Refuah Shelayma for Aaron Hamill
